A regular meeting of the Faculty Senate Courses & Curricula (FSCC) Committee convened at 1:30pm in 129 Himes Hall at the LSU Campus, with the Chair being present. There were no public comments, and the minutes from the previous meeting of Feb 27, 2026 were approved unanimously.

Revised Proposals

HIST 6002 - Motion by Moorthy to Approve, passed unanimously.

MATH 1510 - Motion by Moorthy to Conditionally Approve, passed unanimously. Syllabus needs clearly identified course objectives, as required by SACSCOC.

MATH 1520 - Motion by Moorthy to Conditionally Approve, passed unanimously. Syllabus needs clearly identified course objectives, as required by SACSCOC.

Bachelor of Social Work - Motion by Moorthy to Conditionally Approve, passed unanimously. Please change semester 1 to give two ILC options, e.g., PSYC 2000 or POLI 2051.

COMD 4756 - Motion by Parker to Approve, passed unanimously.

AAAS 4200 – Motion by Parker to Reject and Resubmit, passed unanimously. FSCCC requests a more detailed course description beyond catalogue description. Syllabus lacks a rounding statement and an attendance policy. Proposal says that the course also is open to graduate students, but the justification indicates that the course is for undergraduates. Moreover, proposal does not give any information in the

syllabus about how graduate student will be evaluated. Please clarify which student population, undergraduate, graduate, or both, is the target. Proposals selected repeatable, but information on repeating needs to be in course description. Delete "This course" from course description.

ACCT 3999 – Motion by Heneghan to Reject and Resubmit, passed unanimously. Syllabus needs to define "good citizenship" in the context of a study abroad course and how this will be evaluated. Syllabus needs PS-22 and Academic Continuity statements and defined course objectives.

ANSC 4018 - Motion by Moorthy to Approve, passed unanimously.

ANSC 4092 - Motion by Moorthy to Approve, passed unanimously.

Animal Production Concentration – Tabled

ENTM 7011 - Motion by Dubanksy to Conditionally Approve, passed unanimously. FSCCC requests that faculty check that time allotted for final presentations is adequate. This course seems to be similar to ENTM 4019. Clarify in description how this differs from ENTM 4019.

AGRO 7100 - Motion by Dubanksy to Conditionally Approve, passed unanimously. AGRO 4060 is listed as a pre-requisite course in the proposal, with allowance for a similar course or experience. Please change to “or Permission of Department” for these latter cases. Please clarify how late assignments works with PS-22. Please check that sufficient time is allotted for final paper plus oral presentation in the last week.

ENTM 4019 - Motion by Dubanksy to Conditionally Approve, passed unanimously. Course description needs to be edited for appropriate language and needs to differentiate from 7011. Course number on syllabus (ENTM 4011) does not match the proposed course number.

TAM 3227 - Motion by Dubanksy to Conditionally Approve, passed unanimously. Course proposal does not describe how participation is evaluated. Attendance is described. Possibly, separate attendance from participation. Syllabus needs a rounding policy

Education, M.A. - Motion by Dubanksy to Approve, passed unanimously.

Elementary Education 1-5, M.A.T. - Motion by Dubanksy to Approve, passed unanimously.

Elementary Education 6-12, M.A.T. - Motion by Sathivel to Conditionally Approve, passed unanimously. Proposal adds two courses into program and removes elective, but did not specify which elective is being removed

School Librarianship Graduate Certificate- Motion by Sathivel to Approve, passed unanimously.

LHRD 4150 - Motion by Sathivel to Reject and Resubmit, passed unanimously. Syllabus needs rounding statement. FSCCC recommends condensing course objectives. Six objectives are too many. Syllabus needs academic continuity for both 7 and 15 week and explanation for participation grade.

Dubanksy motioned to adjourn; motion approved. The meeting adjourned at 2:20pm.
